

Mini Camp Summer 2012

Information and Policies

Mini Camp Dates

- Mini Camp is divided into three, week-long sessions, immediately following Turning Point's Specialist Camp (during weeks 2, 3 and 4 of Specialist Camp):
 - Monday, June 18 – Friday, June 22 - \$180
 - Monday, June 25 – Friday, June 29 - \$180
 - Monday, July 2 – Friday, July 6- \$145 (no camp on July 4)

Mini Camp Hours

- Hours for Mini Camp are Monday through Friday from 12:10 pm until 3:00 pm (except for Wednesday, July 4, when camp will be closed).

Location

- Mini Camp will be held at the Grassy Area, Room 110, Room 111, and Room 112.
- Early Pick-Ups (before 3:00 pm) will be signed out from Room 110.

Sign In Procedures

- All students will be escorted to the grassy area for the start of Mini Camp at 12:05 pm; they will not be signed in until 12:10 pm to allow a grace period for late pick-ups.
- Those who have not pre-purchased Mini Camp weeks will still be able to attend for a daily fee of **\$50 per day**, charges will be billed accordingly. These charges will begin at 12:10 pm.

Dismissal Procedures

- Dismissal is between 3:00 pm and 3:10 pm from the Grassy Area.
- Mini-Campers must be signed out daily with the time and signature.
- All Mini-Campers must be escorted by an adult to their cars during this time.
- Mini-Campers will only be released to those individuals listed on emergency forms.
- Any change in pick-up arrangements **must be made in writing by 2:00 pm**.
- Mini-Campers are sent to After Camp Care and will be signed in at 3:10 pm.

After Camp Care

- After Camp Care hours are between 3:10 pm and 6:00 pm for a fee of \$20 per Day.
- After Camp Care can be pre-purchased, through the Business Office, for a fee of \$18 per day if the full 39 days of After Camp Care are purchased for the summer.
- If After Camp Care is not paid for in advance, charges will be billed accordingly.
- A late fee will be imposed if your child is picked up after 6:00 pm. The late fee is \$20.00 for every half hour, or fraction thereof, past 6:00 pm.

Mini-Camp Conduct

- To maintain a positive and supportive environment, it is necessary that the proper atmosphere of respect and cooperation exist during Mini Camp hours. Students are expected to act responsibly and to be polite and courteous with peers and all members of the faculty and staff.

Primary Nap

- To stay with the consistency of the school year, returning Primary students enrolled in Mini Camp will have a rest period from 1:00 – 2:00 pm each day. Cots will be provided, however **blankets will need to be brought from home.** The blankets should be placed in a clear, plastic, shoe box sized container with a change of clothes. A space will be provided for student boxes to be left until the last day of Mini Camp. The Primary nap area will be held in the After Care room of Building 1.

Medication

- Any medication to be taken during Mini Camp hours must be taken to the Front Desk by a parent or guardian.
- Any student who is required to take any medication prescribed to him/her by a physician may be supervised by designated Mini Camp personnel, only if the school receives a written statement from the physician detailing the method, amount and time schedules by which such medication is to be taken.

Lunches

- Lunch will begin at the beginning of Mini Camp on the Grassy Area.
- Please pack a nutritious lunch for your child and **two** drinks. They will need food and water to fuel their active bodies.
- No gum is allowed on campus.
