Tuition covers the cost of providing the full academic program for each student, including instructional materials, receipt of one yearbook per student, PSA fees, milk/juice, study tours, and overnight educational trips, if applicable.

Sibling discount

Each additional child receives a \$300 discount on tuition.

Placement fee

A one-time entrance fee of \$1,500 per child is required for each new student.

Payment plans

Payment plans are stipulated on the enrollment contracts.

REGISTRATION: \$2,000 non-refundable registration fee, which is part of tuition, is due upon enrollment.

ONE-PAYMENT PLAN: Tuition is paid in full by July 1.

TWO-PAYMENT PLAN: Tuition is divided into two equal payments by July 1 and December 1.

After School Care

After School Care is available for full-day Primary students from 2:45 pm to 6:00 pm, for Elementary from 3:30 to 6:00 pm and for Middle School from 3:40 to 6:00 pm. The daily rate for After School Care is \$20. After School Care is purchased in advance at a minimum of ten days for \$20 per day. If you purchase 50 days or more at one time, the daily rate is \$18 per day. Any unused days will be refunded or rolled over to the following school year. After School Care is organized by level with age-appropriate activities, including time for homework. A newsletter and calendar tells you what you can expect for the upcoming month.

After School Programs

A variety of After School Enrichment Programs are available for all levels (Primary must be full day) at additional cost, usually \$160 + materials per semester. Classes run from 3:15-4:15 pm for 10-12 weeks and include such activities as drama, sports, karate, music, dance, art, cooking, readers' workshop, and science.

Tuition assistance request form

Turning assistance at Turning Point School is determined by a family's ability to contribute to the student's educational costs, an evaluation of the family's household income information and review of the family's current tax information. Once a student is admitted to Turning Point School, assistance is determined and renewed annually on the basis of demonstrated financial need without regard to gender, race, religion, or national and ethnic origin.

The tuition assistance program is guided by our belief that parents have an obligation to pay the educational expenses of their children to the extent they are able. While we are committed to providing assistance to families who need supplemental funding for an independent school education, please be aware that funds are limited, and therefore not all requests can be met.

Parents requesting assistance are required to complete a financial application and submit current tax returns. Applications are provided through the service of a third party vendor online and information is sent confidentially to Turning Point School.

Families wishing to apply for tuition assistance should complete this form; return it with the enrollment application and fee prior to the deadline. Please fill out one form per family.

All requests for tuition assistance are kept confidential. Please direct your inquiries regarding tuition assistance to the Business Manager who will ensure confidentiality of all applications.
